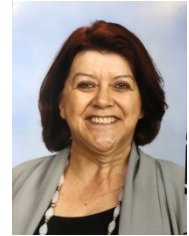




Welcome to the 2019 ASME National Conference

PAYMENT OPTIONS

When registering, delegates can

1. Pay by visa or master card at that time (charges apply)
 - a. Tax receipts will be issued
2. Opt not to pay by credit card and receive a Tax Invoice by email after which
 - a. Pay by EFT via details published on the Tax Invoice
 - b. Pay by visa or master card over the phone (charges apply)
3. Part payments are acceptable as above (EG personal payment for accommodation + organisational payment for registration)

CANCELLATIONS

Cancellations will be assessed on a case by case basis. Full refunds will only be granted if replacement registrations are received. Refunds will exclude accommodation, food and beverage deposits / costs.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF REGISTRATION

Delegates, upon registration, accept that

1. Names, organisations and email contacts may be provided to
 - a. Event sponsors
 - b. Future ASME event planners
2. They may be captured in photos taken and video recorded during the event which may subsequently be used by ASME sanctioned affiliates

CONCURRENT SESSION SELECTIONS

The full program of concurrent sessions and social events is available to delegates select their preferences when they register if they wish. This requires you to review the full program on line and note your selections prior to linking to the registration page to complete your registration. If you do not wish to select your concurrent sessions when you register, you can select when you arrive at conference but some sessions may have filled and it will not be possible to provide you with an individualised program showing what you have selected and where those sessions are located. Delegates are advised that some sessions may be provided by commercial entities.

ACCOMMODATION BOOKINGS
